PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Dear Members

Our Club like many other small businesses in the community have just experienced one of the most difficult years of trading of recent times, a year that has seen many businesses close down. You may recall that at last

year's AGM we did predict that it would be a very difficult trading year for the Club – but it actually proved to be more difficult than we thought. It's on public record that a number of Perth restaurants, clubs and cafes have closed in the last twelve months and many more trading under severe financial stress.

Having said that I feel that the Board of Management and the various subcommittees have done a marvellous job in keeping trading losses to a minimum. I hope members can appreciate just how much work has been devoted by your committees in the last twelve months under very difficult financial constraints.

We have been very fortunate in having a group of generous sponsors, with almost everyone from last year renewing their sponsorship for the next twelve monthns, which under the current financial condition of the economy is amazing. I extend my sincere thanks to each and everyone of them and ask that our members please support them when the opportunity arises. In particular a big thank you to Mr Nick Catania and the Board of Bendigo North Perth Community Bank for once again donating \$20,000 and it is my pleasure to announce that we have recently secured another Major Sponsor being Cav Tony Fini who also has kindly donated \$20,000. These contributions will be of enormous financial help for the next twelve months

As I have said before, I do think that going forward the Club needs to make some difficult and maybe unpopular decisions and this would include, trading days and hours.

As many of you would know it has been a year that both myself and more so the Vice President Nunzio Nici have been experiencing some health problems and have not been able to devote as much time as we would have liked to the Club and I would take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to committee member Sal Vallelonga, who has stepped up and carrying a heavy workload in the day to day management of the Club to cover our absence. Sal has also been the driving force in setting up the new Club restaurant, 1934 Ristorante which after a slow

start is now beginning to show some good results.

I am pleased to announce that through our Redevelopment Committee and our consultants we have lodged a Local Development Plan for our properties with City of Vincent and WAPC in which we have requested a rezoning to eight stories and if passed would make our properties worth so much more. Now whether we develop ourselves, joint venture with a developer or in fact sell some of the properties will be a decision to be made after consultation with members and experienced property developers at a later stage. Many thanks to Tony Vallelonga and other members of the Redevelopment subcommittee as well as our consultants Frank Arangio and Tony Cassella for driving the rezoning to this point, the furthest we have ever been.

I do wonder about the long term viability of the Club as we have known it to date. A recent article in the West Australian Newspaper about Clubs in WA showed that many Clubs are closing due to lack of support by members and the lack of interest of the younger generation to become members of a club. In fact one of oldest Clubs in our State of some 125 years, the WA Club is just one of the clubs to close its doors. I believe that a Club to attract members must offer an environment with modern facilities providing entertainment, sporting opportunities, business and social services, be family friendly, with very competitive pricing for quality food and wine in an area that is easily accessible with convenience of parking. So unless we could be confident of providing such a facility going forward, I think the whole concept of members Club needs to be seriously looked at.

I would like to thank the staff for their contribution over the last twelve months together with Chiara Scaffidi and her Ladies Committee who have always been strong supporters of the Club and myself. Also many thanks to my committee for being very supportive during the very difficult last twelve months and as I said earlier a particular thanks to board member Sal Vallelonga.

In finalising, I would take this opportunity to wish all our members and their families a safe, peaceful and enjoyable Christmas and a Happy New Year 2019 – a year in which the Club will celebrate it's 85th Anniversary.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE - FINANCE REPORT



Dear Members

The downturn in revenue over the last 12 months has impacted on the clubs operations.

The operations of the club resulted in a loss for 2018, of \$89,920 before depreciation.

A summary of the prior years is shown below:

(2017 - Profit of \$67, 062 before depreciation)

(2016 - Profit of \$93,473 before depreciation)

(2015 - Profit of \$86,753 before depreciation)

(2014 - Loss of (\$150,479) before depreciation)

(2013 - Loss of (\$121,047) before depreciation)

Over the previous 3 years of profitable trading; the club was able to pay its liabilities on time, carry out improvements each year, along with acquiring new equipment.

This year the club spent \$21,286 (last year \$40,110 and \$63,693 in 2016) on improvements to ensure the members requirements are catered for.

In 2017 the Operations Committee identified the possible impact the slower economy would have on the clubs activities. This enabled the Management Committee to take steps to minimise expenditure so that the impact on the net profit was contained. A reduction of \$82,993 in overheads was achieved this year. (The reduction in 2017 was \$48,607).

Summary

- Over the last 3 years the committee has been able to reduce overheads from \$709,344 per year to \$515,033 per year.
- Membership and sponsorship has increased and this support is welcomed.
- The Bar and Restaurant revenue also increased slightly.

However

- The functions activity and function bookings declined substantially and consequently the turnover dropped significantly .Functions turnover was \$178,305 less than the prior year. (2017 \$433,779 - 2018 \$255,473).
- The club has also been affected by a reduction in rental income and room hire of \$74,745.

Both of these reductions may be partly due to difficult economic times however the club relies heavily on the support of its members for its functions.

The budget for the 2018/2019 year is targeting a break even result. However as with all ventures the support is necessary from many people, including the committee but more importantly ongoing support is necessary from the Members of the club. A big thank you to the members of the Operations Committee for their work and to the club members who regularly participate and contribute their time and sponsorship funds.

MAINTENANCE & SPECIAL PROJECTS

Dear Members,

This year has seen a considerable amount of work completed to our club in order to maintain its structural integrity and uphold its quality and compliance.

As you can appreciate the age of the building means that constant maintenance

is required and this year has seen significant works, especially in the way of electrical, plumbing, roofing, air-conditioning, replacing deteriorated ceiling panels, and cleaning and repairing gutters and downpipes, to touch on some items. Further to this, we were fortunate enough to have Water Corporation provide us with their resources to fix the drainage issues in the carpark. All-in-all there has pretty much been daily trade activity at our Club this year, and these improvements are imperative to provide our members and guests with premium facilities.

Trades are generally given short notice, and we would like to extend our appreciation to these trades, some of whom attended to issues after hours and on weekends, etc. Our building is a wonderful old building, with some great history behind it – if only the walls could talk...! Maintaining its aesthetic presence means that we need to allocate substantial funding, as well as sustaining a tight budget, to keep it operational and provide a space for our members to enjoy.

I would like to take this opportunity to specifically thank members such as John lelati and Vince Mesiti, for their continuous efforts and hard work in helping maintain the current facilities throughout the year.

Again, we are very grateful to our sponsors and volunteers, as well as all staff and committee members for all their hard work to keep our Club working and looking good.



GIUSEPPE BERTINAZZO





Earlier in the year, the Club lost another of our long standing members and supporters.

Giuseppe Bertinazzo died in April but his memory and service will be long remembered.

He studied at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatorium in Milan, and before long had made his professional debut. He

appeared in famous operas in many countries and performed with other famous singers such as Maria Callas, Dame Joan Sutherland, Luciano Pavarotti and Placido Domingo.

Placido Domingo remained a lifelong friend after an accident on a beach in Tel Aviv saw Giuseppe save him and his wife from the surf. Domingo even performed in Perth for Giuseppe. In the 1950s, Giuseppe met and married his future wife in Mauritius where he was performing. The couple returned to Milan where in 1962, performing in an opera with Dame Joan Sutherland, Giuseppe became very interested and intrigued by Australia, and by 1966 the Bertinazzo family had migrated to Australia.


It was from this time that his association with the Club begins. While his career was succeeding in Perth as a singer, singing teacher, journalist for Italian/Australian newspapers and broadcasting on radio, he was fundamental in creating the Perth Opera Company which debuted its first opera, Bizet's "Carmen" in 1966. He starred and supervised in this production and the WA Italian Club Choir performed in the chorus. The production was a great hit and he continued to support the Company for many years, becoming its Patron.

The Italian Club also warmly welcomed Giuseppe to many of its functions and Balls and he would rouse the members with many much loved songs which were enthusiastically accompanied! He joined the Committee and was very active in promoting the Club's many sporting and cultural events through his newspaper article and radio programmes. For his service he was awarded Life Member of the Club.

In 1980 he started a group, The Musicantes which gave young singers an opportunity to perform in concerts and they entertained Club members at functions for many years. Giuseppe was a regular at the Club, always willing to engage in active conversations with his friends about his favourite topics, soccer, Inter, Glory and the latest news from Italy. He was interested in the lives of his friends and always spoke with warmth and care. He will be sorely missed.

THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF OUR FITZGERALD ST BUILDING





2018 marks the 50th Anniversary of the opening of the present Club buildings. It was a culmination and result of the large increase of members due to migration from Italy in the years after World War Two. Clearly the previous Club building which was expanded in 1954 was not large enough to provide a venue in which all its members could meet and socialise. From as early as 1962, the then Committee began to plan for further expansion. Further lots of land were acquired and plans were underway for a new and bigger Club.

This was to include a Main Bar, Members Lounge, Billiards, Darts and Card Playing areas, Restaurant, Gymnasium, Sauna, Conference Room, Library and the upstairs Main Hall and Lesser Hall.

Under the presidency of G.G. Merizzi from 1965-1969, the Club with its ever growing membership acquired its present architectural shape. In May 1967, the contract was signed for commencement of works. Architects Johnson and Cristal were appointed to submit plans and the firm of Fairweather and Son appointed as builders for the project. Sub-contractors, many of which were Club members were also employed. The finance was provided by the R&I Bank of Western Australia, as well as donations from the Italian Government, Flotta Lauro, Lloyd Triestino and Alitalia and others for their donations of decorative features. Local artist Dan Mazzotti was commissioned to create an appropriate symbol and feature for the façade of the building. The Licensing Court provided consideration to the special requirements for the Club. The cost of the building was \$400,000. On the 14th September 1968 the official opening was held on Club premises.

President Merizzi's welcome message reads: "In the history of the Italian Community of Western Australia, the 14th September 1968 will always be an historical date of outstanding importance and significance. It symbolises the achievement of a goal- the completion of a magnificent structure erected on the foundations so well laid by a small group of Italian migrants more than 30 years ago. It will now be possible under first class conditions, in this our new home, to conduct social and other activities which will enable people of Italian origin

and others in the community, to develop understanding and integration in order that, together, we can live and work in complete harmony, in the very best interests of Australia. To all those who have at any time have played a part, large or small, in bringing our dreams to realisation, a sincere "Thank you"."

Now, in 2018, 50 years after this event, the Club is facing another milestone in its proud history. President and Committee must face the future in order to sustain the Club for its members for a further 50 years. They have

been working hard to determine the best way for the Club to continue to be relevant in the coming years. Changes are already being implemented and continue. The Club has always been the heart of the Italian community and this will be more so in coming years. To this end, exciting and ground breaking plans are being formulated so that the WA Italian Club can continue to be relevant in the future, for its members and the wider Western Australian community. We urge all members to take part in the Club's future; frequent the Club and be interested in what is going to occur.



CARCIOFI STUFATI DELLA NONNA ~ NONNA`S ARTICHOKES

Ingredients

- 4 large fresh plump artichokes
- 1 cup frozen peas
- 150gr pancetta or bacon diced
- 1/2 cup white wine
- 1 medium onion
- 3 cloves garlic
- 1/2 cup flat leaf parsley
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- Salt and pepper to your taste




Method

Prepare artichokes by peeling of all outer leaves until the white is seen. Cut the first third off the top, trim the stem and remove any "choke" in the centre. Cut lengthways through the centre, then into three, making sure they are still in wedges. Place in a bowl of lemon and water to prevent discolouration. In a pan on moderate heat, add the oil, garlic, onions and pancetta. Fry together but do not burn. When cooked add the pat-dried artichokes and stir in the oil. When they have become warm, add white wine, parsley and season well with salt and pepper to your taste. Cover with lid for 10-15 minutes always on moderate heat. Add frozen peas and allow to cook through. Add water if sauce is drying. Serve as soon as the peas are cooked.
